Ben -- I'm keeping my options open as far as attending the meeting tonight. Here is my report in case I don't make it.

Paul

A month ago we had two HF antennas -- the GAP vertical and an 80 meter dipole. Both had water in the feedlines. The vertical was only usable on two bands. In addition the vertical had suffered damage during the winter.

Today I am pleased to report these problems have been fixed. The GAP antenna has been repaired and moved to a new location which should help protect it from future damage. The 80 meter dipole has been replaced by a new, stronger one that should provide trouble free service for many years. We currently do not have an antenna tuner. The frequency coverage of our antennas is posted in the primary station area. Although the rig we are using has internal protection from high SWR, I would encourage operators to stay within the posted antenna frequency limits. This is a reasonable precaution, and peformance outside the specified ranges will be poor as the rig reduces power to protect itself from damage.

I would like to thank Ben for his help. The progress made would not have been possible without it.

We have regained our previous HF capability, but the best is yet to come. Two additional HF antennas are planned. These will expand and enhance our HF capabilities and will likely become the preferred antennas for most purposes. We also have yet to install our new 2 meter antenna.

It may be possible to have the additional HF atennas in place before Field Day but I can't promise that. Mostly it

depends on whether Clarence has time to do some tower work for us in the next couple of weeks. I will require at least one week (preferably more) AFTER the tower work is done to complete and tune the new HF antennas.

I would like to thank the club for providing generous funding to support these antenna projects. When all the work is completed, we will have an antenna system far better than any we have had before. Consistent with good engineering practice I am making every effort to maximize HF coverage without requiring an antenna tuner. Nevertheless, given diverse interests of its operators and unforseen circumstances, any club station should probably have a tuner. I hesitate to ask for additional funding on the heels of my initial request. However, if the club wishes to aquire a tuner, a good one can be purchased for \$150 and I feel this would be a sound investment.

Station Manager's Report for June, 2003

We owe thanks to Clarence, AA1PN, for his hard work on the towers. Also to the rest of the antenna crew including Ben, WA1PBR and Terry, N1RCU. The new 2 meter antenna is up 90 feet or more and working great. The two pulleys for additional wire antennas are up on the towers. I am still trying to get one multiband wire antenna up before Field Day.

The progress doesn't end with new PARC antennas! With Clarence's help we are planning to paint the towers and fix up some problems with the tower bases.

We do need to replace the 2 meter transceiver. The HTX-242 is not able to handle the extremely strong signal environment with the weather transmitter running. I do know the ICOM V-8000 holds up very well in this harsh RF environment, with only one possible annoyance: the weather broadcast can be heard on 147.000, which is the frequency of the Lincoln repeater. The ICOM 2100 does not fare as well overall, losing 5 dB of sensitivity across the whole band... but it also doesn't actually hear weather broadcasts on any of the currently active repeater frequencies in the area. Between these two I felt the V-8000 to be a better choice overall. I had planned to test more radios before the June meeting but fell behind on it.

I would like to offer my sincere apology to the club for not having completed the HF antenna systems before Field Day. This is always a busy and stressful time of year. I was sure I would have it done, but my enthusiasm for the K1PQ project was greater than my ability to accomplish the tasks in time. There is still a fair chance that I can get one more antenna completed before the weekend, but the fourth and final one will have to wait.
